

The Faculty organizes and implements its educational programs in accordance with the following policies, based on the policy for conferring degrees established by the Faculty and the policy on the organization and implementation of curricula set by Kobe University.

1. The Faculty offers liberal arts course subjects in order to develop a broad and deep education and a comprehensive capacity for judgment, to cultivate a rich sense of humanity and to achieve the common aim of learning for all students at the university.

2. The Faculty offers courses in major subjects in order to develop a profound knowledge and advanced professional skills and to achieve the common aim of learning for all students at the university and the learning goal set by the Faculty.

- The Faculty offers a Basic course in major subjects (Basic medicine subjects and Basic engineering subjects) and a Course in medical device engineering (Basic medical device engineering subjects and Subjects on the practical application of medical devices) so that students can acquire the ability to develop concepts that meet medical needs, based on comprehensive knowledge and basic understanding of both medicine and engineering.
- The Faculty also offers a Course in creativity (Creativity cultivation subjects) and requires students to engage in Graduate Study so that they can acquire problem-solving skills and the capacity to contribute to the creation of a future society.

3. Classes shall be conducted through lectures, seminars, experiments, practical training (including problem-based learning and experiential learning), or a combination of these.

4. Assessment is carried out in a combined and comprehensive manner in line with the learning objectives, including through written exams, assignments, presentations and active participation.
